GENERAL CAMP RULES

(Rules are necessary, but enforcing them is never fun. So please make our counselors' jobs a little easier by showing respect to all rules and all people at all times.)

- DO NOT** bring personal electronic devices (cell phones, music players, gaming devices, smartwatches, etc.)
- campers will be held responsible for any careless damage done to Solid Rock facilities/property
- campers must attend all chapel services and be present for all scheduled activities
- campers may not leave the dorms after "lights out" unless accompanied by an adult
- pranks, of ANY kind, may only be done with the pre-approval of a counselor
- inappropriate contact or P.D.A. between campers is not allowed
- campers of opposite gender may not go off alone together any time

CAMP DRESS GUIDELINES

***RULE OF THUMB: intentionally seek to glorify God in the way you dress

- no hats or t-shirts with questionable logos, themes, or innuendos
- all shorts, skirts, & dresses must be **NO SHORTER THAN** 4 inches above the knee
- modest sleeveless shirts & tank tops may be worn, but cannot show undergarments
- all campers are encouraged to dress up for the evening services
 - guys: jeans or slacks and collared shirt
 - girls: dress/skirt or jeans and nice shirt
- boys & girls must wear a t-shirt and shorts when swimming and when walking to/from swimming.

CONCESSION STAND/ GIFT SHOP

Parents, you can call the camp to pre-pay a tab for your camper(s) at the concession stand/gift shop. Doing so will eliminate the need for your teenager to bring any cash with them. Cash often gets lost, misplaced, and even stolen when it is not put away properly. Any unused money left on the tab is refundable.

HEALTH & SAFETY INFORMATION

- Prior to our departure for camp, we will do lice screenings on each camper, so please make sure this is taken care of beforehand. We don't want anyone to be denied a trip to camp, but we've had to do it many times before.
- We ask students to stay home if they are exhibiting any flu-like symptoms.
- Campers that bring prescription or OTC meds must turn them in to a youth leader prior to leaving for camp. As required by state law, all meds must be administered through the camp nurses.

Parents are encouraged to write a letter to be given to their teenager while at camp. It's always good for the campers to hear from their loved ones while they are away and getting closer to God. Simply write a letter to your camper, place it in an envelope with your camper's name, and give it to any one of our youth leaders prior to leaving for camp.
